The Glockenhaus was built on top of the basement of an even older house in 1482. "Glocke" is the German Word for Bell and it is very belike that bells were produced and stored in the house for centuries. Nowadays is it used for events and public elections. Please enjoy your dinner in this historic and charming ambience.

How to get there:

The Glockenhaus lies in the middle of Lüneburg – but is a little hidden. Every bus stops at the stop "Am Sande", the big street surrounded by old houses. Facing downhill towards the big church go to the left side of the street to the supermarket Edeka (not Tschorn Edeka). On the left side of the Edeka is a small alleyway. Go through it and keep straight until you cross the street "Glockenstraße". The location will be on you left side.
